Terms and Conditions



The cost per stall is £100, plus 10% of takings along with a raffle prize. There will be a nominal charge of £10 for electricity, and £10 if you require a table. Payment to secure your stall is required within a week of your application being accepted. Non-payment invalidates the acceptance of your application.

The 10% charitable donation needs to be received by the event organisers by 7 November 2025 at the latest. A £50 charge will be incurred for any late payment.

Stallholders must have their own Public Liability Insurance, and provide the event organisers with a copy of the documentation in advance to enable their attendance. A copy needs to be brought on the day in case of an inspection.

Exhibitors are also responsible for their own Employers Liability and Food Hygiene certification (if applicable).

In addition to the organisation's Health and Safety, exhibitors are responsible for safety of their own stand in respect of visitors and merchandise.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to vacate their stall, removing all rubbish by 7pm. A fee of £50 will be charged for failure to do so.

Cancellation. The booking fee is non-refundable in the event of withdrawal from the Fair.

In the unlikely event that the Derbyshire Christmas Fair has to be cancelled, the booking fee (less a nominal handling charge) will be refunded.

GDPR agreement. The organisers will store your submitted information in order to contact you with any queries regarding your attendance.
